

We are able to offer you an uplifting experience that will make a difference to your life and especially to those in need. You may coach soccer to boys (and a few girls) who are between the ages of 7 and 19. You may also help with homework – in particular Math's and English. If you like marketing you may assist with our monthly community newsletter, which we are hoping to start in August.

The ideal placement would be 3 months, however, a minimum placement of 6 weeks is required. However, this year we have secured a building and have started a proper aftercare program which will allow us to take short-term volunteers. Any assistance will be much appreciated, whether it is coaching, reading, painting, supervising – you name it we will have something worthwhile for you to do.

The placement requires people with maturity, willingness to work under extremely difficult conditions, and someone who does not need mothering.

The project runs from Monday to Thursday from 14:00 to until 19.00

If you are not a sport coach – that is fine, there are so many jobs that need attention, that any type of assistance would be greatly appreciated.

Mario, who is from the community, has been running the program for 8 years. Prudence is our project co-coordinator who will assist you with any of your queries.

The South African School Term dates for 2009 are as follows: (they are however, subject to change)

We charge a placement fee of R2000 (approx \$250). The placement fee is given directly to Mario the gentleman who runs the entire project and takes care of all the volunteers. Transport costs can vary from R20 (\$2.50 to \$20 per day). You will always be accompanied by our project co-ordinators. If you would like us to provide accommodation we are able to arrange accommodation for R4500 per month (approx \$600). This does not include any meals.

As the project runs from Monday to Thursday, you are free to explore Cape Town or weekend getaways. Our Travel Desk would be willing to assist you.
